Scholarships

An **Erasmus Mundus Masters Course** provided by three European universities and one Australian university :

- School of Education, Aarhus University, Copenhagen, Denmark
- Institute of Education, University of London, London, United Kingdom
- University of Deusto, Bilbao, Spain
- Melbourne Graduate School of Education, University of Melbourne, Australia

Duration: 2 years full-time

Language of instruction: English

Tuition fee for 2 years amounts to a maximum of €8.000 for European students.

Scholarship: For European students, a **Category B scholarship** covers the tuition fee and €500 monthly allowance for two academic years.

Admission criteria

- A Bachelors or Masters degree with good marks from a recognised institution of higher education.
- A high level of spoken and written English: IELTS 7.0 or TOEFL 650 (written paper test) / 280 (computer based test) / 100 (internet based test) is mandatory.
- Relevant work experience in the area of policy and management in governmental, inter-governmental, nongovernmental organisations, private enterprises and institution related to lifelong learning is valued.
- An academic qualification essay based on research literature on any aspect of lifelong learning.

The deadline for Category B applications: 1st February 2011.
